
What do the resources provide?

Some children will have already joined their Google classroom which can be viewed by selecting Google for Education. Once selected, children will be asked to verify their email address with Google. Enter the full Hwb email address again.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- Make sure you enter the child's email address with _____@hwbcymru.net
- Check you have correctly entered the class code
- **If you are using the device for multiple people, check that you are in the correct account, one of the biggest problems that we found is that the device will go to the default account set to the computer.**
- There are lots of Google classroom tutorials online if you are experiencing difficulty.
