 Parents informed individually of start date for their child by email next week.

Week 3

Mon 14th – Fri 18th September 2020: Staggered start dates for Nursery.
 Parents informed individually of start date for their child by email next week.

Social distancing and hygiene procedures will continue to be in place.

Arrangements through the day

Parents must wait on the other side of Dryden Road until we call your child's class to line up to come in to school.

Children must wear school uniform. However, on the day their class has PE, children can wear PE kit to school. Therefore, no PE kits are to be kept in school.

Children will have their own stationery provided by school, so no pencil cases are to be brought in.

Breaks and lunches will also be staggered. As of September, the school dinner service is expected to re-start, with a choice of packed lunches or school dinners.

Breakfast Club will not be available in the first few weeks; we will send information regarding this provision in September. However, please be aware that the number of places available will reduce and be prioritised where the need is essential.

We thank you for your support and patience throughout these past months. It has been difficult at times to organise new systems and processes, especially when we often hear things at the same time as the general public. We continue to put the children's wellbeing and education to the forefront of all our decisions.
