Key Stage 2 Parents – Years 3 - 6

Dear parents / carers,

All Key Stage 2 classes (year 3 ó 6) will be returning to school on Monday 15th March, in line with Welsh Government guidance.

On Thursday and Friday this week, Teachers will be involved in preparing for the children¢s return on Monday. Therefore, there will be limited interaction online, however live sessions will take place.

Procedures in school

- Pupils are to wear uniforms. However, we understand children will have grown and shops arenøt accessible, so consideration will be given (children can wear just jumpers/cardigans).
- Children can bring in a snack, water bottle and packed lunches. No other items are needed to be brought in from home.
- Hot school dinners will be available from Monday 15th March.
- These two weeks will focus on wellbeing and Class teachers will discuss work completed at home with children.

Social distancing measures

- All adults must wear a mask around the school gates and maintain social distancing.
- Classes will be in bubbles and not mix with other classes.
- Hand washing / sanitiser will be used.
- One way system in place around school.
- Children will sit side-by-side and face forward, where possible.
- Staff will wear masks around school and in class where necessary.
- School is involved in weekly testing of staff.
- Playtimes and lunchtimes will be staggered during the day for each class.
- There will be no Breakfast Club or After School Club provision.
 After School Club will begin after Easter.
 Breakfast Club procedures will be reviewed after Easter.

Please note: If your child or a family member has Covid-19 symptoms, you must inform school and they must self-isolate at home.

Please note: Covid-19 restrictions continue outside of school, so children are unable to mix in home circumstances.
