On Wednesday years 3 & 4 had a special visitor Khalid, who works for a charity Blackburn Charity Trust+. Khalid visits countries that have suffered natural disasters, taking aid to help them. He showed them pictures and videos of a recent visit to Morocco where an earthquake had destroyed many of the people's homes. Year 3 & 4 learnt a lot about all the things people need to survive for a few weeks and were amazed at how important emergency packs were. Each pack cost £44 and included just the basics. They realised how lucky we are with what we have and could barely imagine living in a tent with just the clothes we are wearing in temperatures that reach minus 10 in winter. Khalid is planning to visit again in December to take warm quilts and more food and we are going to be fundraising to help. A huge thank you to Khalid! The children were enthralled listening to his adventures.
