We will endeavour to arrange a 'Leaver's Event' for when we are able to, so be assured you will have the opportunity to celebrate your time at Fairfield together.

In order to ensure the wellbeing of all children and families during this difficult time, we ask that either parents or children make contact with their teacher once a week through google classroom. If we don't hear from you we will make contact to ensure everyone is safe and well, and if any support is needed.
