When we arrived we went on to the Pier to look at the formation of the cliffs (from a distance!).

We learnt that the Alabaster from Penarth cliffs was used to decorate buildings in Cardiff, such as Cardiff Castle and the University Buildings.

Next, we explored the rocks on the beach, using all our senses (and a rock identification app) to decide what type of rocks they were. We ended by creating natural art using the rocks inspired by Andy Goldsworthy. It was a wonderful day and all the teachers were very proud of the behaviour of the children.
