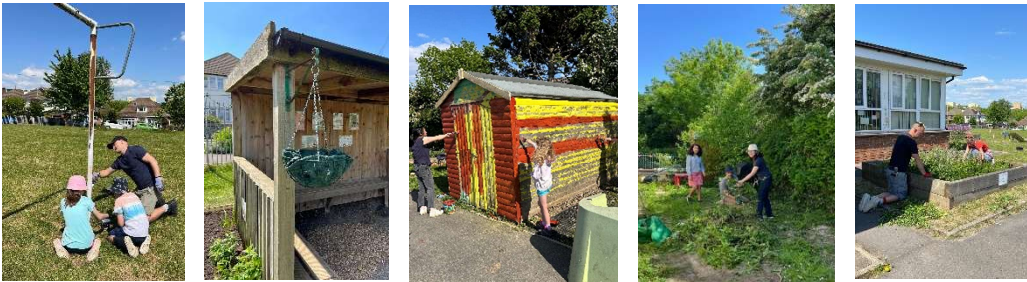


# Fairfield News
