And congratulations to Lily who won Gymnast of the week and Seren who was awarded 'Best Smile / Show Face' in her dance school. We are very proud of you all!



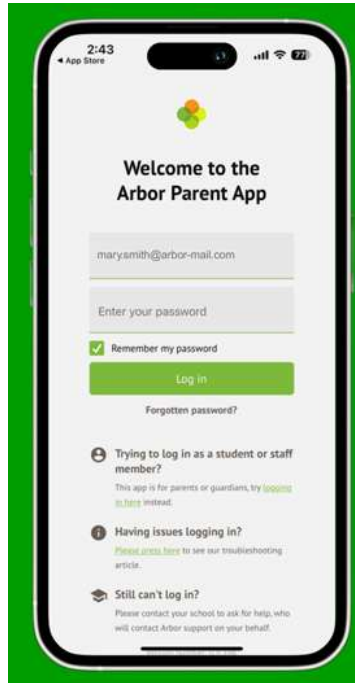
