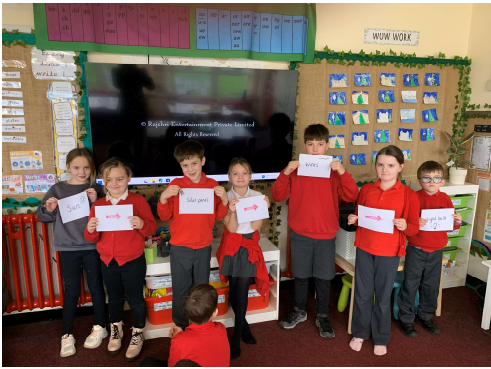


Fairfield News
