Tanni Grey-Thompson Visit

On Monday 9th March, Fairfield Primary School had the incredible honour of welcoming Tanni Grey-Thompson to our school for a very special visit.

Tanni spent time with a small group of our pupils from Years 3–6 – Jack, Flo, Seren A., Amelia, Zion, Cavalli and Ella – for a filmed discussion about sport, participation and how being active makes young people feel. Sitting together around the table in our Haven Room, the pupils spoke confidently about the sports they enjoy, what motivates them to take part, and how sport can help people feel proud, confident and part of a team.



Tanni asked the children thoughtful questions about their experiences of sport, including what they enjoy most, what might stop someone from taking part, and how schools can make sport even better for everyone. The pupils represented Fairfield brilliantly, sharing their ideas honestly and showing great maturity in their responses.

It was a wonderful opportunity for our children to meet such an inspiring athlete. As one of Britain's most successful Paralympians, Tanni's achievements and passion for sport continue to motivate young people to believe in themselves and try new things.

We are extremely proud of the pupils who took part and grateful to Tanni and the filming team for visiting Fairfield. It was a memorable experience that truly celebrated the power of sport and the importance of every child finding an activity they enjoy.
