Visit from a Member of the Senedd Year 5 & 6 Workshop

On Wednesday 10th June, Year 5 and Year 6 were lucky to welcome a special visitor from the Senedd to our school. She delivered an engaging and informative workshop all about democracy, voting, and the Youth Parliament.

During the session, we learned a great deal about how decisions are made and how people can have their voices heard. She explained important concepts such as petitions, manifestos, and political parties, helping us to understand how these are used in real-life politics.

As part of the workshop, we took part in a fun and exciting mock election. 4 chosen children split into four different parties, each creating their own ideas and campaign promises to present to the rest of the group. After listening carefully to each party's proposals, everybody was given a ballot paper to cast their vote for their chosen candidate.

The experience of voting felt very real and helped us understand the importance of making informed choices. After all the votes were counted, the winning party was the Fortnite Party, much to the excitement of many pupils!

It was a fantastic opportunity for the children to learn about democracy in a practical and memorable way. We would like to say a big thank you to our visitor for such an enjoyable and valuable session.
