## St Cyres Science Rocket Workshop

On Monday, we were delighted to welcome the Physics Lead from St Cyres School, who delivered an exciting and engaging rocket science lesson for Year 6.

The children began by learning about space exploration and watched the launch of Artemis II. Inspired by this, they worked in teams to design and build their own rockets using plastic bottles, cones and fins.

Once their rockets were complete, the children headed outside to put their designs to the test. Using water and air pressure from a bike pump, each group launched their rocket and timed how long it stayed in the air.

There was plenty of excitement as the rockets soared across the playground! Congratulations to the winning team of Xavier, Rio, Anniev and Rhys, whose rocket achieved an impressive flight time of 3.18 seconds.

A huge thank you to the St Cyres Physics Lead for providing such a fun, hands-on learning experience that brought science to life.

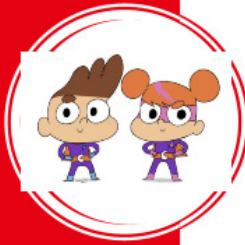
